## WHO'S DRIVING THE PURPOSE DRIVEN CHURCH?

It was in 2007 that I wrote an article called, "The Destruction of the Southern Baptist Convention." <sup>1</sup> I had read some other books on the subject of the *Purpose Driven Life*, plus my own encounter with President Dr. Jeff Iorg of Golden Gate Baptist Theological Seminary, who had aligned himself with Rick Warren and his movement.

In July of 2010, I was given a copy of the book, "Who's Driving the Purpose Driven Church," by James Sundquist. This book made me numb because I had not realized how destructive and depraved Warren's teaching was and how it is worse than the material produced by the Jehovah's Witnesses or the Mormons.
